

# OUR HISTORY

*The first women's club in Solano County*  
Saturday Club was established in 1909 to pursue "The musical improvement of its members, and the stimulation of musical interest in Vacaville".

Saturday Club's past projects included advocating for music teachers in the schools, establishing Vacaville's first public library, establishing a senior club, sponsoring USO events during World War II, sponsoring an Immunization Clinic for Solano County, supporting the "Save the Trees" Initiative in the 1970's, and beyond.

Through the years, the Club donated funds or use of the clubhouse to the Art League, Meals on Wheels, the Vacaville Museum Guild, the Concert Society, Vacaville Public Education Fund, Opportunity House Homeless Shelter, North Bay Opera, Gaslighters Theatre Company, Starbound Theatre, Young Artists Conservatory of Music, and other local organizations and performing arts groups.

Saturday Club celebrated its 100th Anniversary in 2009 and the Club received a State of California Resolution recognizing its contributions to the Community and the Arts.
